

IGNOU Assignment Marks & Evaluation Criteria

IGNOU assignments are a compulsory component of the evaluation system and play a major role in a student's final result. Understanding the **marks distribution and evaluation criteria** helps students write better answers and avoid unnecessary mistakes.

Weightage of IGNOU Assignments

- Assignments carry **30% weightage** in the final result
- Term-End Examination (TEE) carries **70% weightage**
- Both assignment and TEE marks are **mandatory** to pass a course

Even if a student scores well in the exam, low assignment marks can affect the final grade.

Passing Marks for IGNOU Assignments

- Minimum **40% marks** are required to pass an assignment
- For most courses:
 - 40 out of 100 (or equivalent) is considered pass
- Assignment marks and exam marks are evaluated **separately**

Failing to pass the assignment requires **re-submission in the next session**.

How IGNOU Evaluates Assignments

IGNOU assignments are evaluated at the **Study Centre level** by appointed academic counsellors. Evaluation is done strictly as per IGNOU academic guidelines.

Key Evaluation Parameters

1. **Relevance to the Question**
 - Answers must address what is asked
 - Irrelevant content leads to mark deduction
2. **Concept Clarity**
 - Clear understanding of the topic
 - Correct use of terminology and definitions
3. **Answer Structure**
 - Proper introduction, main content, and conclusion
 - Logical flow of ideas

4. **Word Limit Compliance**
 - Answers should match the marks-based word limit
 - Overwriting or under-writing may reduce marks
 5. **Presentation & Format**
 - Proper cover page
 - Neat handwriting or clear typing
 - Correct question numbering and spacing
 6. **Originality**
 - Answers must be written in the student's own words
 - Plagiarism or copying may result in zero marks
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Marks Distribution per Question

IGNOU usually follows this pattern:

- **5-mark questions:** Short answers (50–100 words)
- **10-mark questions:** Medium-length answers (100–200 words)
- **15-mark questions:** Detailed answers (250–300 words)

Marks are awarded based on **content depth, clarity, and completeness**.

Assignment Evaluation Timeline

- Evaluation generally takes **30–45 days** after submission
- Marks are uploaded online by the Study Centre
- Delay may occur due to:
 - High volume of assignments
 - Administrative processing
 - Regional Centre coordination

Students should regularly check assignment status.

Viva Voce & Practical Evaluation (If Applicable)

Some programmes (especially **MCA, B.Ed, Diploma, and practical courses**) include:

- **Viva voce**
- **Practical assessment**

Marks from viva/practical are added separately and are mandatory where prescribed.

Where Do Assignment Marks Appear?

1. **Assignment Status Portal** – first update
2. **IGNOU Grade Card** – after TEE result declaration

Assignment marks must appear before final result is generated.

What If Assignment Marks Are Low or Missing?

- Contact the **Study Centre** with acknowledgement slip
- Request verification if marks are not uploaded
- Re-submission may be required if assignment is failed

Keep all submission proofs safe until marks are reflected.

Tips to Score Better Assignment Marks

- Follow IGNOU format strictly
 - Write answers in your own words
 - Stick to the syllabus
 - Use headings and subheadings
 - Submit assignments on time
