

IGNOU Assignment Status Check Guide

After submitting IGNOU assignments, students must regularly check their **assignment status** to confirm whether the assignment has been received, evaluated, and marks have been updated. Assignment marks are mandatory and contribute **30% weightage** to the final result.

This guide explains how to check IGNOU assignment status step by step.

When Should You Check IGNOU Assignment Status?

- **30–45 days after submission** at the Study Centre
- If marks are not visible before the Term-End Examination result
- If you need confirmation for exam eligibility

Checking too early may show “not found,” which is normal.

How to Check IGNOU Assignment Status (Step-by-Step)

Step 1: Visit the Official IGNOU Assignment Status Page

Go to the official IGNOU assignment status portal.

Step 2: Enter Required Details

Fill in:

- **Enrollment Number**
- **Programme Code** (BA, MA, BCA, MCA, MBA, etc.)

Make sure details are entered correctly.

Step 3: Submit and View Status

Click on the submit button. The screen will show:

- Course code
- Assignment marks (if updated)
- Status of evaluation

If marks are updated, they will later reflect in the **Grade Card**.

Meaning of Assignment Status Messages

- **Marks Displayed:** Assignment evaluated successfully
- **Blank / Not Updated:** Evaluation still pending
- **Not Found:** Assignment details not uploaded yet or data entry delay

Do not panic if marks are not immediately visible.

How Long Does Assignment Evaluation Take?

- Usually **30–45 days** after submission
- Delays may occur due to:
 - High number of assignments
 - Study Centre workload
 - Data upload delays

Marks are uploaded study centre–wise.

What to Do If Assignment Marks Are Not Updated?

If marks are not updated even after a long time:

- Contact your **Study Centre**
- Carry your **assignment acknowledgement slip**
- Check with your **Regional Centre** if required

Never discard the acknowledgement receipt until marks appear.

Difference Between Assignment Status and Grade Card

- **Assignment Status:** Shows evaluation progress and marks upload
- **Grade Card:** Shows final marks after TEE result declaration

Assignment marks appear first in status, then in grade card.

Common Issues Students Face

- Entering wrong enrollment number or programme code
- Checking status too soon
- Submitting assignments late
- Losing acknowledgement slip

Always double-check details before submitting.

Important Tips for Students

- Submit assignments well before the deadline
 - Keep a scanned copy of submitted assignments
 - Save acknowledgement receipt safely
 - Check status regularly, especially before exams
