

# IGNOU Study Notes – Standard Format

## Header (Mandatory)

- **Programme:** (e.g., BA, MA, B.Com, MBA)
- **Course Code & Title:** (e.g., BEGC-101 – Indian Classical Literature)
- **Block & Unit No.:**
- **Topic / Sub-topic:**
- **Date:**

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## 1. Introduction (3–4 lines)

- Brief definition or overview of the topic
- Context or background (historical/theoretical)
- Relevance to the syllabus

*Tip: Write as if answering a 5-mark question intro.*

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## 2. Key Concepts / Definitions

- Concept 1 – short explanation
- Concept 2 – short explanation
- Important terminology (bold or underline keywords)

Use **bullet points**, not paragraphs.

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## 3. Core Content (Main Body)

Divide into clear sub-headings exactly as in SLM:

### 3.1 Sub-heading One

- Explanation (3–5 bullet points)
- Example / case (if applicable)

### 3.2 Sub-heading Two

- Explanation
- Diagram / flowchart (if possible)

IGNOU examiners prefer **structured answers with headings**.

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#### 4. Diagrams / Tables / Flowcharts

- Simple hand-drawn or text diagrams
- Comparative tables (very effective for 10-mark answers)

Example:

Aspect Type A Type B

Meaning

Features

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#### 5. Important Points for Exams

- Frequently asked themes
- Repeated PYQ areas
- Keywords to include in answers

This section is critical for **last-day revision**.

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#### 6. Previous Year Question (PYQ) Link

- Example:  
*“Discuss the significance of ... (June 2022, Dec 2023)”*

(Optional but highly recommended)

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#### 7. Conclusion (2–3 lines)

- Summary of the topic
- Contemporary relevance / closing remark

Always include a conclusion in 10- and 15-mark answers.

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#### 8. Keywords / Quick Revision Box

- Term 1
- Term 2
- Term 3

Use this for rapid recall before exams.

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## Handwritten Notes Guidelines (Very Important)

- Use **blue/black pen only**
- Headings: CAPITAL or underlined
- Margins for keywords
- Avoid long paragraphs
- Leave space to add points later

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## Digital Notes (If Typing)

- Font: Calibri / Times New Roman
- Size: 12 (text), 14–16 (headings)
- Line spacing: 1.3–1.5
- Highlight keywords in **bold**
